### Remembering Dave


As most of us know, we lost one of our great leaders and a friend this past March. Dave Fearis was one of my favorites. A Boilermaker, an accomplished Superintendent, and an individual who put service first both locally and nationally, Dave's accomplishments in the industry read like a Who's

Who. He served on numerous HAGCSA Boards and was our President in 1989. He would ultimately go on to serve on Boards for the GCSAA which culminated in becoming National President in 1999. He served as President of the First Tee of Greater KC. In 1990 he was bestowed the Chester H. Mendenhall Award for his Outstanding Service. He got it again in 1998! Dave would receive the GCSAA's Col. John Morley Distinguished Service award in 2016. He was inducted into the Kansas City Golf Hall of Fame in 2020. Now that is a list. Every trade magazine and the national publications in golf reported his passing. Dave Fearis was a pretty big deal!

Now, a lot of guys with that kind of pedigree might let it go to their heads. Not Dave. He was always kind. He would always seek you out. He would always engage and make you feel bigger than you deserved. I can recall several GIS shows where Dave, in his Past Presidents blazer, would see me and call me over to introduce me to some big shot VIP and all of the sudden, I belonged. That was just Dave. Inclusive, genuine, kind. I always admired that in him. But that is what true leaders do.

One of my favorite memories with Dave happened on a warm, sunny day in May of 2003. Tom Watson was holding a Junior Golf clinic at Heart of America Golf Academy. Dave had asked me to come volunteer. You don't say no to Dave. He and Watson had become friends. The Watson Challenge had been held at Blue Hills for many years. Of course, I was a big fan of Tom. When it was time for a picture, Dave got all of us together. Seeing Dave in the back row, I immediately tried to trade places so he could sit next to his friend. Dave shook his head, introduced me to Tom and told him that I was President of the Heart that year. Watson graciously shook my hand and told me to sit down and smile. That picture sits on a shelf in my den. When I look at that image, I think of Dave, not Tom Watson.

It is how I will remember Dave Fearis. Like one of my mentors, Nels Lingren, Dave's final few years were sadly consumed by Alzheimer's. I feel very fortunate to have known these men in their prime. I will remember the kind, genuine, inclusive Dave who always made time and put me at ease in his circle.


