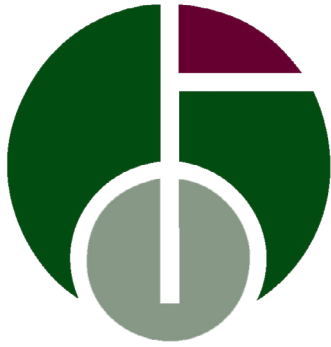

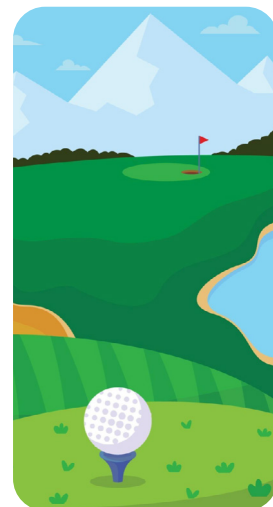

Guide For Recognizing Outstanding Members

Brian Breedlove Equipment Manager of the Year

This award will be presented annually to the equipment manager who has demonstrated dedication at their job over the past year.

The guidelines are as follows:

1. Must be a member of the Heart of America GCSA (Class EM); an in good standings.
2. Represents organization to the highest degree professionally and individually.
3. This award shall be governed by the equipment manager's achievements in any of the following.
 - Competent in mechanical skills.
 - Utilizes problem solving in an effective and efficient manner.
 - Assists course preparations if needed
 - Applies fiscal responsibility
 - Goes "Above and Beyond" to "Help the Cause."
4. These accomplishments must have occurred in the current year.

Assistant Superintendent of the Year

This award will be presented annually to the assistant who has demonstrated dedication and excellence at their job over the past year.

The guidelines are as follows:

1. Must be a member of the Heart of America GCSA (Class C); an in good standings.
2. Must be an assistant that represents their profession to the highest degree.
3. This award shall be governed by the assistant's achievements in any of the following.
 - Competency in agronomic skills
 - Ability to efficiently run the daily operations of the course
 - Effectively running course projects
 - Assisting in the preparation of their course for regional or national events
 - Involvement with local, regional, or national turf related associations
 - Strong involvement in course renovations and new course construction
 - Goal oriented and striving to become a superintendent
 - Exceptional contributions to this association through involvement
4. These accomplishments must have occurred in the current year.

Superintendent of the Year

This award, established in 1970, has been presented annually to the golf course superintendent who has demonstrated dedication and outstanding service to his or her profession.

The guidelines are as follows:

1. Must be a member of the Heart of America GCSA (Class A or Class B) in good standing.
2. Must be a superintendent that represents the organization and himself to the highest degree.
3. This award shall be governed by the superintendents achievements in either:
 - Excellence in golf course management
 - Preparation of his or her course for regional or national golf tournaments
 - Achievements for renovation or new golf course construction
 - Involvement with local, regional, or national turf related associations
 - Exceptional contributions to this association through involvement
4. These accomplishments must have occurred in the current year.

Chester Mendenhall Award

This award has been established to honor an individual who has devoted extensive time and effort to the promotion of golf, the art of greens-keeping and other related fields. Begun in 1983, this award is named after a golf course superintendent who dedicated his life to his profession.

The guidelines are as follows:

1. Must be a member of the Heart of America GCSA and in good standing.
2. Must be an individual that represents the organization and him or herself to the highest degree.
3. This award shall be governed by the individual's achievements over an extended period of time:
 - Outstanding service to this organization
 - Involvement with local, regional, or national turf related organizations
 - Continued support and service to the golf industry or his/her community

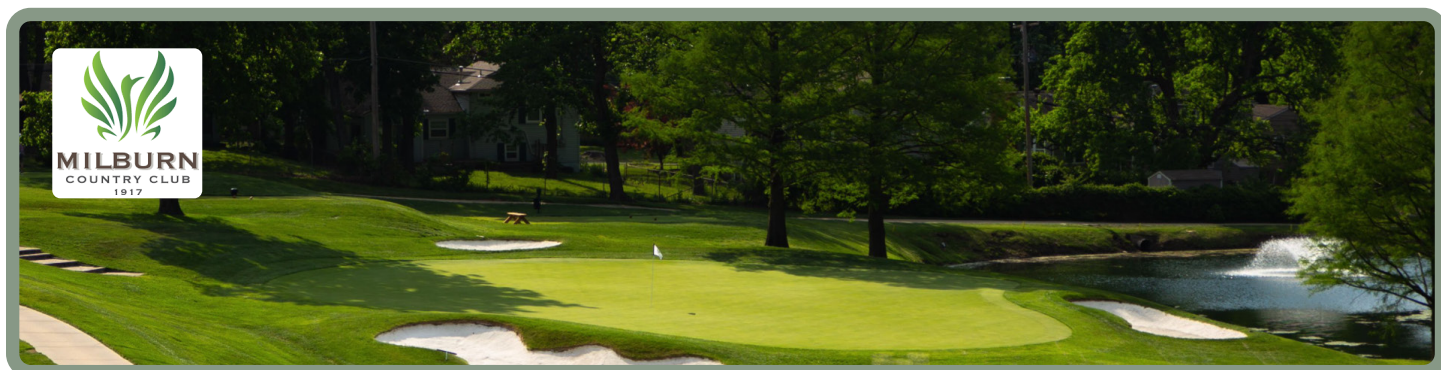

I'm pleased to inform to you that the Heart of America GCSA has its first CTEM member. Daniel Heinze, CTEM, Equipment Manager at the Kansas City Country Club in Mission Hills, KS. He is the 12th person in the world to hold this unique certification and the first from the Kansas and KC metro area. Daniel Heinze, CTEM is a native of Kansas City. He holds a B.S degree in golf course management from K-State University. His dedicated career spans 14 years and includes time in Boston, Massachusetts and Glenwood Springs, Colorado. Daniel and his wife Whitney reside in Overland Park and are expecting their first child in December.

I wanted to make sure you are aware of the new certification GCSSA launced in May for equipment managers. The Certification Turf Equipment Manager (CTEM) program is a true certification, just like CGCS is for superintendents. This is the highest professional achievement available to any turf equipment manager in the world. **For more info visit:** <https://www.gcsaa.org/education/certifications-exams/why-ctem>

To qualify for entry into Certification Turf Equipment Manager (CTEM) a turf equipment manager must meet the following requirements:

- Have completed the EMCP Level 1 and Level 2 programs
- Have at least 3 years of experience in equipment management
- Be employed as the head equipment manager at the facility for at least 6 months.

(1) To earn the certificationm the EM's maintenance facility must pass a rigorous attesting process conducted by fellow CTEMs. The attesting is looking at the EM's routine maintenance practices, safety protocols and all of the envrionmental protocols in place.

(2) Upon passing the attesting process, the new CTEM will be given a 5-year renewal period in which he/she needs to earn 5 points to renew the certification. This is an oppurtunity for the chapters to expand EM education, because these members will be looking for those education points to meet the renewal requirements.

I hope that you will congratulate Daniel and the golf course superintendent at Kansas City Country Club, Pat Rose for the support of the program and promotion of the new CTEM program. 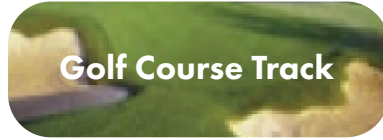

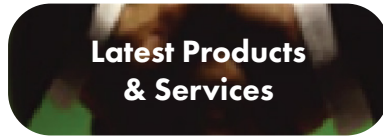

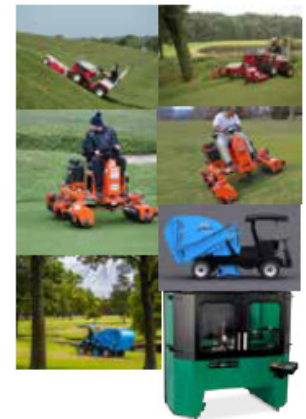
